TEAM CAPTAIN INFORMATION

1. Entry form must be complete, and full entry fees paid for team, doubles, singles and optional all events. TSUSBC is not able to provide doubles partners. It is the team captains responsibility to find team members, doubles partners and substitutes unless an emergency,
2. Optional All Events Fee: Optional all events fees must be paid prior to closing date of entry. Entrants do not have to be entered in all three events and **it is recommended** an investment be made by an individual entering an event(s) if she is used as a substitute to complete all three events. **The All Events fees can not be accepted after entry closing.**
3. Please indicate **three different dates and three different times.** The first choice of preferred weekends will be considered (all three times); if first choice is filled, the same consideration is given for second choice (all three times), etc. If squad time request is the same for three different weekends, we will assume the squad time is more important than the weekend. One time will be considered for each of the preferred weekends. If you are limited as to the weekends you may bowl, it is suggested that you get your entry in as soon as possible. Almost 90% of the team entries received requests the middle squads; therefore, these are the first to fill. Please communicate with TSUSBC, list earlier or later squads as 2nd and 3rd preferences.
4. TSUSBC Women's Championship Tournament office will make every effort to accommodate teams wishing to be scheduled at the same time provided the entries are received in the TSUSBC Tournament office within a reasonable time. If at all possible, teams doubling together should send entries and fees in the same envelope. Consideration will be given to special requests for scheduling (crossing lanes- do not want to cross lanes, etc.) - if
 - Team Captain notes so on "Official Entry Form" in space provided for crossing or not crossing
 - All other requests, should be included with the "Official Entry Form"Teams may be assured, their requests will be granted, if at all possible, however, no guarantees are made for scheduling doubles and singles.
5. ENTRY FORMS WITH RULING B & C AVERAGES - Team captains will be responsible for obtaining the average verifications from local association.
6. TEAM CAPTAINS: Please notify your team members of the following:

All participants must have USBC Membership Cards or proof of membership indicating USBC number, signed by the local association manager when checking in for each event. Participants without proof of USBC membership will be subject to purchasing a USBC Affiliate Membership Card.

PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUESTED TO wear **SUITABLE ATTIRE** WHEN PARTICIPATING IN THE TSUSBC WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT. SKIRTS, SHORTS (LENGTH-fingers do not touch skin when arms are extended at side) AND SLACKS ARE PREFERRED, NO HALTER TOPS. Information regarding what is considered **SUITABLE ATTIRE** will be included in confirmation material mailed to each team captain. PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR TEAM MEMBERS (THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS A TEAM CAPTAIN. If the tournament officials believe the dress does not meet the requirements, bowler(s) will be asked to change.

All Captains shall report to the tournament office (check in table) at least 45 minutes prior to the time of scheduled bowling. Team captains or designate shall record all scores on the re-cap sheets.

In the event of a mechanical failure, it is hereby agreed that the bowlers affected shall be moved to the next available pair of lanes

Entry is limited to female members of the Texas State USBC who have a qualifying average for participation, as follows:

AVERAGE RULING A: The entering average shall be the bowler's highest average of 21 or more games in one league at the end of the previous winter league season (**2006-2007 Yearbook average**).

AVERAGE RULING B: If ruling A does not apply, the bowler will use her highest 21 game average (either current or summer) as of January 1 with written verification at the time entry is sent in.

AVERAGE RULING C: If rulings A & B do not apply, the bowler shall use her highest average of 21 or more games at time of participation with written verification from local association manager, or league secretary.

USBC Tournament Rule 319a-2 will not apply. An average shall have been established in USBC leagues, and/or sanctioned youth or collegiate division leagues, **WITHIN THE STATE OF TEXAS**. The highest qualifying average shall be used whether the bowler was a substitute or a regular member of a team at the time it was established.

Unless otherwise noted in the entering average rules. Rule 319a 1, 3, 4 and 5 shall apply. 319d reporting prior winnings shall apply.

The total prize fund after deducting the cost of Championship Plaques or Trophies and engraving will be distributed on the basis of at least one (1) cash prize for every ten (10) entries in the team, two member team (doubles) and the individual (singles); and at least one (1) cash prize for every twenty (20) entries in the All Events. Tournament prize money to be distributed in accordance with USBC rule 309.

SUBSTITUTES: A scheduled entrant will be allowed to bowl one additional time in the TEAM and DOUBLES EVENT only to fill unexpected vacancies as a substitute. A bowler may sign up ONLY once as an original team, doubles, singles member. Substitutes will take position of bowler and no rearranging of the lineup will be made. Substitutes averages must meet average rulings, A & B or C. **Substitutes should be reported to the TSUSBC Women’s Championship Tournament office as per the instructions sent with confirmation letter, but no later than 1 hour before squad time on site at the tournament office located in each center.** In the event of disability or emergency after the game has started, a substitute will be allowed, if one is available. **Once a sub begins an event the original entrant may not enter the games.**
