

## TEXAS YABA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OUTLINE

1. The scholarship is payable to any educational, business, technical or vocational institution in the United States or Canada. Special payment may be made on courses taken at a college/university during high school years. Such payment will be reviewed on a case by case basis before funds are released.
2. To have payment of your scholarship sent to the institution of your choice, you must:
  - a. Advise the Texas YABA of your admission acceptance or that you have already registered.
  - b. Provide us with proof of admittance or registration
  - c. Give us the name and address of the institution.

\*\*Note: it will take approximately two weeks to prepare a check to be mailed to the school. Please allow this time factor when requesting your scholarship payment, especially if you want the check to be at the school prior to the registration.

3. In the event you receive scholarship awards from other individuals, those should be used first to cover payment on tuition or other charges. You may use this scholarship for tuition, room and board, or books and supplies. In case of other scholarships or a use that is not listed above, you are to inform Texas YABA so the scholarship committee can make other arrangements for the payment of your award in such a manner as to ensure it will be used in support of your higher education.
4. The scholarship award is not contingent upon grades or the number of hours you will attempt. However, if for any reason you should leave school or drop all classes, any remaining funds will revert back to the Texas YABA scholarship fund in your name until you either request the balance or the scholarship expires - whichever comes first.
5. Under the policy, you are required to enter your choice of schooling prior to your 23rd birthday. The scholarship will expire and revert back to the general scholarship fund on your 23rd birthday if not previously requested. Should there be circumstances that delay you from meeting this policy guideline, please send a written explanation if you want to request a one year extension of your scholarship expiration. This request should be mailed to the Texas YABA office. It will be given to the scholarship committee for review and decision of the extension approval. You will be notified of their decision.
