

TSUSBC Youth Leader Scholarship Tournament and Premiere Junior Gold Qualifying Event  
2026 USBC Certification No. (Pending)  
Junior Gold Qualifier Rules

- 1) Tournament Dates, Squads and Location: March 21, 2026 – 9:00AM and 2:00PM; March 22, 2026 – 9:00AM and 2:00PM Lucky Strike Euless, Euless TX
- 2) Participation in the Junior Gold (JG) qualifier is open to all USBC Junior Gold members. Junior Gold qualifier participants must show their 2025-2026 USBC Junior Gold membership card
- 3) Junior Gold qualifier event entry fee is for \$62.50 (U18, U16), \$50.00 for U14) or \$37.50 (U12. This is in addition to the Scholarship Tournament squad entry fee of \$45.
- 4) Each day of the scholarship tournament shall constitute a separate Junior Gold Qualifier. Multiple participation in the Scholarship Tournament is allowed; however, each Junior Gold qualifier participant may enter the JG qualifier only once.
- 5) Subject to Junior Gold minimum participation requirements of 4 girl and 4 boy Junior Gold members, the Junior Gold qualifiers will be run in separate boys and girls divisions.
- 6) If the minimum number of boy or girl qualifiers is not met for the, U18, U16 , U14 and U12 divisions, boys and girls will be combined in one U18, U16, U14 and U12 division.
- 7) The JG qualifying score will consist of the 6-game scratch total from the participant's qualifier squad.
- 8) The high scratch qualifier in each division from the two combined squads each day will be awarded a standard entry in the 2020 Junior Gold Championships.
- 9) Additional standard 2020 Junior Gold Championship entries, if available, will be awarded on a ratio of 1:4 or major fraction in each division from the two combined squads each day. Where applicable, Enhanced Advancer Ratio Policy entries will be offered.
- 10) If necessary, tiebreaker for positions awarded shall be determined by highest game(s) scratch bowled in the JG qualifying squad.
- 11) In the event there is not a 1:4 Ratio the funds will be returned to the participant in the form of a scholarship.
- 12) Any Junior Gold qualifying event entry fee overages, along with funds raised through a ball raffle at the tournament, shall be divided equally among the top boy and girl qualifiers in each division across both days of the tournament as the "premiere" event subsidy.
